- **BBX COMMENCES SMALL EXPLORATION FIELD PROGRAM ON JUMA EAST**

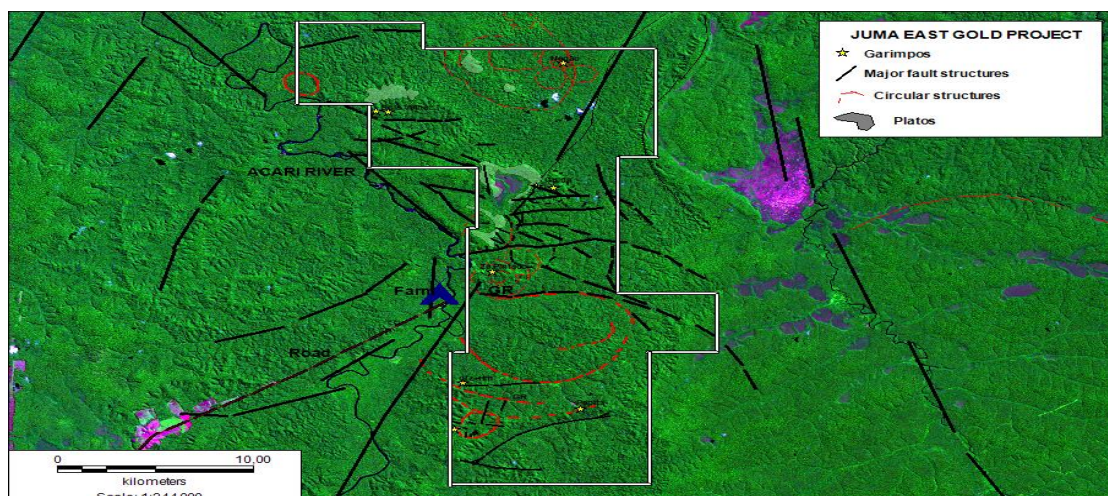
#### JUMA EAST UPDATE –

BBX has commenced a small 20 day exploration field program on Juma East with the aim of locating and sampling all old workings around the GUIDA plateau. (refer map 1 & 2).

Gold has been mined on the GUIDA plateau from extensive mineralized zones within friable quartz. The plateau is covered in widespread quartz float fragments, derived either from a quartz vein system or of alluvial origin. Gold has been recovered from the majority of the drainages that drain the plateau.

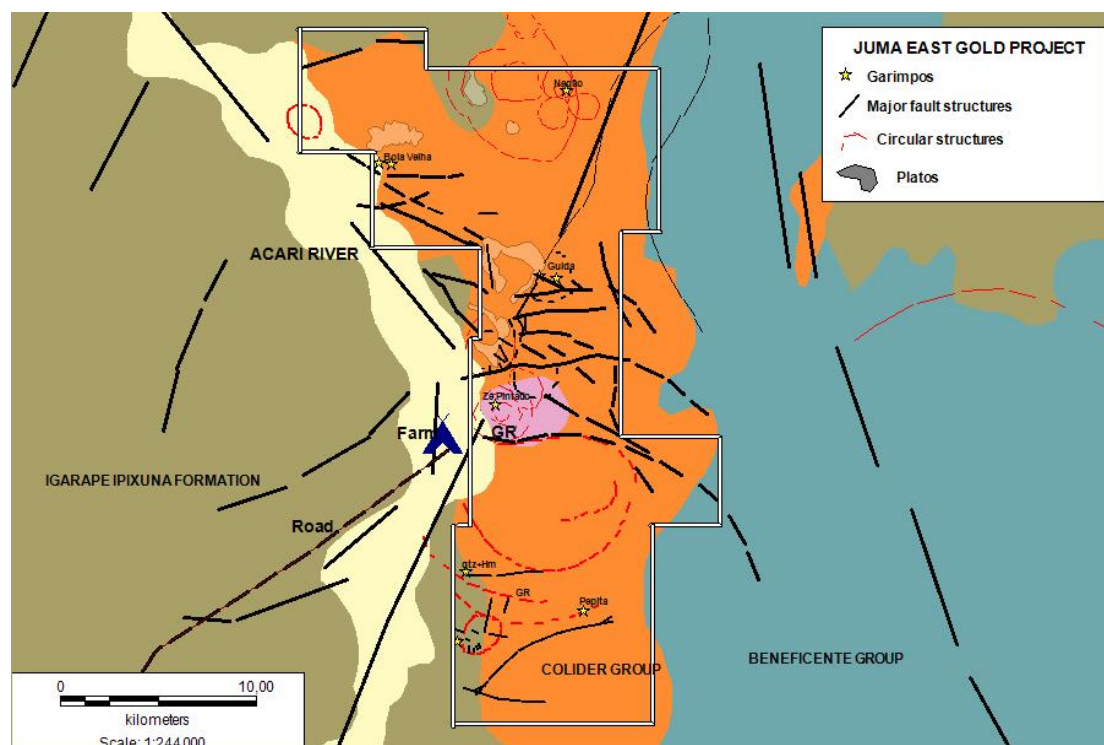
Soil sampling and channel sampling of exposed saprolite will be conducted.
